Shooter of the Year Tournament Dates

To be eligible for Shooter of The Year archers must post scores from 7 tournaments. These scores will be the best of:

4 Spot Tournaments (each is pro-rated to a maximum of 300 points)
(New for 2025) 3 Circuit 3D Tournaments (raw score) - one at each 3D club
(Midlands, Keowee, TAB)

The SC State 3D Championship (raw score) TAB

Shooter of the Year is awarded to the Archer with the highest cumulative score from the 8 events.

SCAA 3D Classes are used to determine SOY. Bowhunter B is not recognized as a competitive class for Shooter of the Year. Archers must shoot in the comparable NFAA class for the NFAA/SCAA sanctioned events. Class winners are awarded a Shooter of the Year trophy.
